## VIP Transportation

Assist players with getting their courtesy cars by picking them up at airport and returning them to airport after tournament. Prior to the tournament, volunteers assist with picking up cars from the dealership and bringing them to the course. Tournament week usually consists of eight-hour days.

## Course Evacuation

Volunteers place vans on course in designated areas for players, caddies, walking scorers and standard bearers to get them off of the course during inclement weather and returning them back out when play resumes. Tournament week consists of eight-hour days.

## Caddies

Volunteers assist with all caddies needs at caddie shack, distribute caddie bibs prior to play, and help retrieve caddie bibs after play.

## Marshals

Volunteers assist on the course at various positions for help ball spotting for players and keeping crowds away from players and their golf balls during play. Some marshals assist in driving EVAC vans off and back on course during in climate weather. Volunteers usually work 1 hour before play and end after play is done for the day.
